### Color Theory

#### Acrylic paint or designer gouache

**Tip:** Liquitex sells a student set of acrylics which have specific colors for color theory. Get the one with: cyan and magenta, yellow and black and white (Ivory Black, and Titanium White). From here build other colors. Have a warm and cool of each color. For example: alizarin crimson, viridian green, cadmium red, cadmium yellow, lemon yellow, ultramarine blue, cobalt blue, cerulean blue.
